

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SLYERS ROAD, STINSFORD

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Slyers Road from Stinsford Hill House for a distance of approximately 250 metres in a westerly direction. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 18 November 2024 between 0930 and 1530 and remain in force for five days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 18 November 2024.

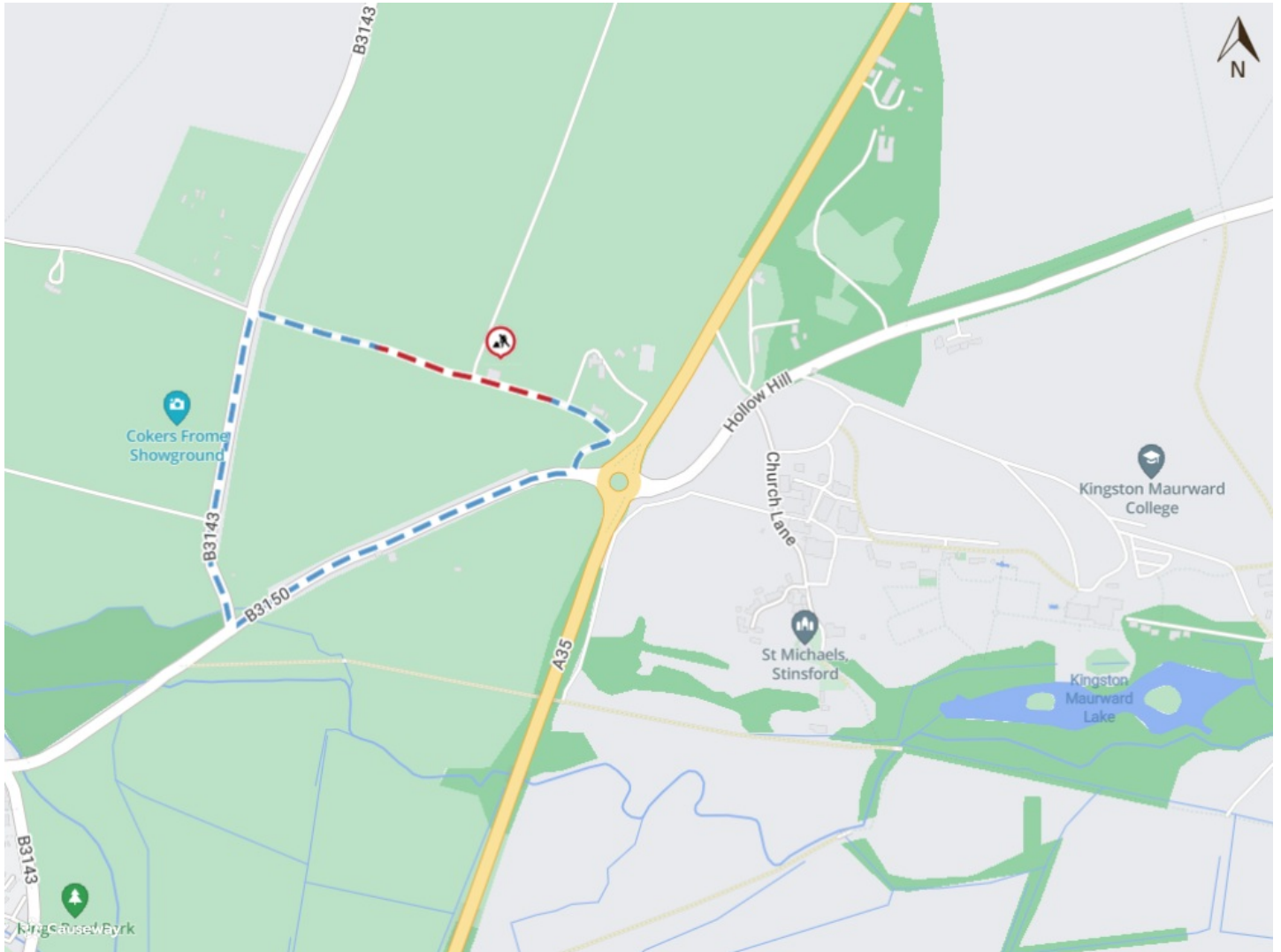
This Notice will enable Dorset Council safe access to carry out essential highway maintenance works.

There will be a locally signed diversion route.
